Choosing varieties with high brown-patch tolerance gives you a better pitch quality, more playing hours and a reduced reliance on fungicides. 4turf® varieties and several outstanding diploid varieties have proven to be highly tolerant to brown patch.

As climate change brings more hot and humid weather, the severity and geographic range of fungal diseases are

increasing. Disease control has become a greater challenge for many turf managers as they seek to reduce pesticide use.

Brown patch is becoming more common across Europe. The disease tends to occur during hot, moist summers, when it causes severe damage and dramatic reductions in pitch quality. In the worst cases, it can lead to the loss of an entire pitch.



WHAT IS BROWN PATCH?

Brown patch is a turfgrass foliar disease caused by *Rhizoctonia* spp. The fungus can attack all cool-season turfgrasses, but is most devastating to perennial ryegrass, bentgrass and tall fescue. Attacks are triggered by hot, humid conditions.
